### **Unemployed? File for Unemployment Insurance Benefits at our office.**

Unemployment Insurance is temporary financial assistance for eligible workers who lose their jobs through no fault of their own.

To collect benefits, you must be *ready, willing, and able to work, and actively looking for work during each week in which you are claiming benefits.*

To qualify for Unemployment Insurance benefits, you must have worked and earned enough wages in covered employment. In New York State, employers pay contributions that fund Unemployment Insurance. It is not deducted from your paycheck. The Department of Labor

Unemployment Insurance Division decides if you qualify for benefits.
