

#### October is National Disability Employment Awareness Month (NDEAM)

The theme for National Disability Employment Awareness Month (NDEAM) in 2024 is "Access to Good Jobs for All." NDEAM is celebrated in October each year to recognize the contributions of people with disabilities to the American workplaces. This year's theme emphasizes the commitment to ensuring that disabled workers have access to good jobs yearround. It also stands for ensuring that all employees have equal opportunities to grow and contribute.

The origins of NDEAM date back to 1945 when Congress declared the first week of October as "National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week." In 1962, the title changed by dropping the word "physically" to include individuals with all types of disabilities. In 1988, the event was extended to a month and renamed to reflect the broader focus on employment for all individuals with disabilities.

The DOL's Office of Disability Employment Programs (ODEP) leads the NDEAM observance each year, providing resources and coordinating events to promote the employment of people with disabilities and support their integration into the workforce.

How ever you choose to take part, you'll be playing an important role in fostering a more inclusive workforce, one where every person is recognized for their abilities—every day of every month.


